

Ordinance 93-3
Relating To The Feeding Of Gulls And Ducks
On Any Property Owned Or Leased By The Town

Whereas, gulls and ducks are acknowledged to be major carriers for the parasite causing "swimmer's itch" and

Whereas, caustic droppings from gulls and ducks cause severe damage to paint on automobiles, render the town dock and waterfront facilities distasteful to swimmers, picnickers and walkers, and most importantly,

Whereas, congregations of gulls cause great concern to the pilots of helicopters providing emergency services to the Northwoods Hospital.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Phelps Town Board this 8th day of November, 1993 that it is a misdemeanor to feed gulls or ducks on any property owned or leased by the Town of Phelps. Be it further ordained that violators of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25 or more than \$50 for each offense.
