## Ordinance 96-1 Adoption of State Traffic Codes

The Town Board of the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Applicability and Enforcement:

A. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all highways, roads, streets and alleys within the limits of the Town of Phelps.

B. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the officer(s) of the Town of Phelps, by the Vilas County Sheriff's Department and by the Wisconsin State Patrol. This Ordinance shall be enforced according to the procedures set forth in sections 66.12, 345.11 through 345.61, and Chapter 799, Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2. State Traffic Laws Adopted:

A. The statutory provisions in Chapters 340 to 348, Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment, are adopted, and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made a part of this Ordinance in order to secure uniform state-wide regulation of traffic on the roads and highways, streets and alleys of the Township of Phelps, and State of Wisconsin.

## Section 3. Penalties:

A. Forfeitures for violation of the state statutes adopted by reference in this Ordinance shall conform to the forfeiture permitted to be imposed for violation of such statutes as set forth in the Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, including any variations or increases for subsequent offenses, which schedule is adopted by reference in this Ordinance. In addition, the penalties set forth in Section 349.06(3), Wisconsin Statutes, are also incorporated by reference as apart of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date:

A. This Ordinance shall become effective the day after passage and publication, as provided by law.
