

Resolution # 2015-2


WHEREAS, Ted Ritter has served Vilas County and the Town of Phelps residents as the Vilas County Invasive Species Coordinator since 2004; and


WHEREAS, over those years, Mr. Ritter's contributions to the Town of Phelps residents has far exceeded his duties;




