

Ordinance 97-1
Snowmobile Ordinance

Whereas, the Town of Phelps has, pursuant to Section 350.04(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, power and authority to designate streets, appropriately marked, as snowmobile routes;

Now, therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Phelps, Vilas County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. That the following streets or roads are designated as snowmobile access routes:
 - Pillsbury Lane (.2 miles)
 - Schroeder From Pillsbury to Power Line (FR2573) (.5 miles)
 - St. Louis From (FR2533) to Deerskin (.8 miles)
 - Deerskin From St. Louis to Joseph Wisniewski Residence (.2 miles)
 - Deerskin From End of Trail to Northern Exposure (.4 miles)
 - Tower Road From Highway 17 to Cemetery Entrance (.1 miles)
 - Davies Road From Bill Davies Driveway to Shooting Range Road (.5 miles)
 - Gravel Pit Road Between the Two Trail Entrances (.8 miles)
 - Big Sand Lake Road Between the Airport and TR-12-36 (.1 miles)
2. No other Town roads shall be used as snowmobile routes.
3. All of said snowmobile routes shall be appropriately marked with signs designating such routes before they can be traveled by snowmobiles.
4. Snowmobiles shall be operated on the extreme right side of the roadway.
5. Left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on snow cover and other prevailing conditions.
6. Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
7. Highways designated for snowmobile operation shall be marked in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 350.13.
8. Snowmobile operation is not permitted on state trunk highways or connecting highways except as provided under Wisconsin Statute 350.02.
9. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall forfeit not more than \$250.00.
10. Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part other than the part so declared to be invalid.
